



PROGRAM DIRECTOR REPORT By Aaron Meyer

Merry Christmas everyone!

In past newsletters, I've told you about the Esox Workshop discussions, and that we're looking at two significant issues with the intention of making changes to muskie and pike management.

It's a fairly widespread belief that many of our muskie populations are on a downward trend right now. This has been a major topic of discussion at recent workshops, and the DNR is taking a very serious look at the situation. The muskie technical committee has been working diligently on first; seeing if there really is a problem, second; figuring out what the problem actually is, a third; finding ways to remedy the situation. They've made a lot of headway in understanding the "big picture" of muskie management, and are looking at possibilities for how we can do it better in the future. On the surface, the quick fix might seem to be simply stocking more muskies. The reality is that it's much more complex than that. Putting more fish in does NOT necessarily mean seeing more fish grow up. What I can tell you, for now, is that I think we're moving in the right direction, but I don't know what the whole answer will be. In a future newsletter I'll dive more into the details, and try to explain what the biologists are finding.

On the pike side, it's long been recognized that our pike management strategy in MN has been failing miserably. It simply doesn't do enough to protect pike from overharvest. To make matters worse, the DNR has been handcuffed by a cap on the number of lakes where they can try special regulations. The direction we're hoping to move here is a complete overhaul of the system. We're looking at breaking Minnesota into 3 zones where pike management needs to differ based on lake type, spawning success rates, growth rates, etc. The intention is to balance out our pike fisheries, bringing them into more stable numbers while increasing the opportunity to catch nice sized pike AND in some cases actually increase harvest opportunities. It's going to require a sweeping change in angler understanding and attitude. To put it simply, in much of MN we need to keep FAR MORE small pike, while keeping FAR FEWER mid-sized and larger pike. When the time comes, we need to support this effort with everything we've got. The overall health of our entire fisheries depends on it.
