



This is in regard to the Legislature forcing the DNR to reduce the number of lakes with special pike slot regulations to no more than 100 statewide. With roughly 4,000 pike waters in MN, and a huge majority of them suffering from the "hammer-handle" syndrome, it's really a shame to see the regs that can change things for the better be limited to only 100 lakes.
