Our next meeting will be the Dick Pearson seminar! This will, no doubt, be one of the most interesting and informative seminars of the year! Because of scheduling issues, we will be at the SAUK RAPIDS American Legion instead of our usual location. February 6th at 7:00 pm. Be there! Well, things have gone away from simply letting biologists properly manage our resources and in several cases we've found ourselves fighting political and legislative battles. The problem is that once one or more legislators buy into an idea and write the legislation, you are fighting a losing battle. Sadly, there's no question that we will continue to see this type of poor management legislation coming at us over the next few years.

At the MMPA, we've decided that we need to change direction a bit. Rather than always being in the opposing position, it's time for us to start working to provide positive ideas to our legislators. We need to propose and promote legislation that will do GOOD things for the future of our fisheries. Legislators aren't out there wanting to harm our fisheries but in many cases they don't fully understand the impact that their management decisions can have. Our aim is to provide them with good management ideas and get the ball rolling in the right direction. We'll be looking at various ways to protect and better manage our muskies and pike.
